St Andrew's Presbyterian Kirk believes in helping our children to build a special relationship with God. Our objective is to provide an age appropriate curriculum which helps children to relate the Bible and its lessons to their everyday life, learn about God, the person and work of Jesus, and the men and women of the Old and New Testament.



Children accompany their parents for worship service at 10:30 am and are invited to join Sunday School classes immediately following the Children's Message, approximately 15 minutes into the Service. Classes are held in the Kirk Hall.

There are excellent nursery facilities available for families with children from birth to 3 years old.

St Andrew's Kirk has Sunday School classes for each of the following age groups:

- † 4-6 years
- † 7-9 years
- † 10-12 years
- † Teens group

Ages 4-12 follow the **Route 52™** curriculum, a range of books covering topics which explore the history, poetry, prophecy and the good news of God's Word. Lessons are informative and interactive, with hands on activities which are relevant to the age group and based on sound scriptural themes.

The Teens' group meets in the Eneas Parlour on the second and last Sunday in each month. They remain in regular worship service during the other remaining Sundays. The Teen curriculum is centred on the relevance of the Bible in their everyday lives and the challenges of living a Christ-like life under the pressures of being a teen in today's fast paced world.
